- The analyse of your art-work: 1 (one) page (1800 characters)
- A short biography of no more than 10 lines (about 600 characters)
- 1 (one) colour transparency (6x6 cm, minimum) or 1 (one) image scan (300 DPI, 210x147 mm or 147x210 mm) of a representative art-work. (This must be clearly identified with the artist´s name and the title of the work)
- 1 (one) photograph (or 1 image scan) – author´s portrait.
- Please, complete the list of the art-work by the insurance amounts.

We are looking forward to your participation at Insita 2010 and to our further cooperation. If you need any other information, do not hesitate to contact me.

IMPORTANT: Please note there is change in the dates of the exhibition:

The opening of the exhibition INSITA will be **3 July 2010** (instead of 19th June written in the Protocol) and the exhibition will take place in the Slovak National Gallery, Bratislava and in the Gallery INSITA in Pezinok till **26 September 2010**. Other dates indicated in the Protocol remain without changes.
